REGULATION**

I. General Provisions

1. The Training and Coworking Center for the Study of Renewable Energy Problems at the National Research University "Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers" (hereinafter referred to as the Center) is organized within the framework of the **ERASMUS+ Higher Education Capacity Building Projects101128871 - DEBSEUz - ERASMUS-EDU-2023-CBHE digital project "Development of a Targeted Education Program for Bachelor's Degree Programs in Solar Energy in Uzbekistan (DEBSEUz) "** in order to study energy problems, promote energy saving and improve personnel qualifications, as well as in cooperation with the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation of the Republic of Uzbekistan and 7 higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan and 3 universities of the European Union in order to implement the international project **"Development of a Targeted Education Program for Bachelor's Degree Programs in Solar Energy in Uzbekistan (DEBSEUz) "** and study energy problems, promote energy saving and improve personnel qualifications.

2. The Center is a structural subdivision of the National Research University "Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers" in the form of an institution without the status of a legal entity. The Center has its own name and logo and is used for the approval of documents signed by the director within its competence in agreement with the rector of the institute, vice-rector for scientific work and innovations.

3. In its activities, the Center is guided by the Constitution and laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan, resolutions of the chambers of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, decrees, resolutions and orders of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, resolutions and orders of the Cabinet of Ministers, regulatory legal acts and instructions of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, orders of the National Research University "Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers" as well as these Regulations.

4. The Center carries out its assigned tasks on the basis of close cooperation with similar research centers of the republic and abroad, as well as with research institutions of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan and other similar research institutions.

5. The Center is headed by a director with an academic degree. The Director of the Center reports directly to the Vice-Rector for Research and Innovation of the university.

6. The Center plans to conduct classes in specialized subjects for the educational fields "Renewable Energy Sources," "Energy Engineering," and the master's program "Alternative Energy Sources."

II. TASKS OF THE CENTER

7. The main goal of the training and co-working center **Within the framework of ERASMUS+Higher Education Capacity Building Projects101128871 - DEBSEUz - ERASMUS-EDU-2023-CBHE "Development of a Targeted Education Program for Bachelor's Degree Programs in Solar Energy in Uzbekistan (DEBSEUz) "** Implementation of the international project and training of personnel in solar panels as alternative energy sources, research of energy problems.

8. The main tasks of the Center are:

- Conducting scientific research aimed at a comprehensive in-depth study of energy problems and alternative energy sources (water, solar, wind) and regular promotion of energy saving, advanced training of personnel, research of energy problems;

- Scientific study of energy sources and energy saving opportunities, training of scientific and pedagogical personnel in this area, as well as conducting research work jointly with domestic and foreign partners;

- Scientific study of alternative energy sources in our country, assessment of their potential;

- Organization of scientific research on new energy sources;

- Conducting scientific conferences, seminars, and round tables at various levels on alternative energy sources and energy conservation;

- Based on the study and scientific analysis of energy saving and alternative energy sources, develop recommendations for introducing the concepts of energy saving into the topics and curricula of the bachelor's and master's degree programs of the institute;

- Improving the qualifications of teachers and researchers by organizing scientific seminars, round tables, and various scientific conferences dedicated to energy saving;

- Monitoring and ensuring the timely implementation of research work on energy saving and their study, carried out within the framework of state scientific programs in higher educational institutions;

- regular publication in republican and institute publications of materials introducing the activities of the Center and scientific results achieved in this area;

- Organization of work on the translation into Uzbek of the most authoritative scientific works devoted to alternative energy and energy saving;

- Involvement of leading energy scientists working in our country and abroad in the work of the Center.

- Development of start-ups, innovative projects together with talented students, master's students, doctoral students, Establishing close cooperation with

research institutions of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan conducting scientific seminars and presentations of projects.

9. In accordance with the tasks assigned to it, the Center performs the following functions:

- carries out research work and implements developments in production, based on the University's research work and the Center's work plan;
- Organizes seminars, round tables, conferences on topical issues of energy;
- Based on the approved plan of the University and the Center, prepares analytical articles and reports to inform the general public about the research results;
- participates in the preparation of training courses and educational literature in cooperation with foreign specialists;
- participates in other analytical projects that do not contradict the goals and objectives of the University;
- Attracts professors, teachers, students, researchers, masters of the University, as well as employees of government bodies, representatives of analytical centers, scientific institutions, and specialists from foreign countries to organize the work of the Center;
- Coordinates, in cooperation with departments, final qualifying works, master's and doctoral dissertations, various scientific research and analytical projects on alternative energy and energy saving;
- develops proposals for the study and implementation of advanced foreign experience in conducting scientific research on alternative energy and energy saving;

III. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE CENTER

- creation of temporary working groups, permanent expert groups on a public basis in the implementation of scientific and analytical research;
- The Center may have other rights in accordance with the legislation.

- creation of temporary working groups, permanent expert groups on a public basis in the implementation of scientific and analytical research;
- The Center may have other rights in accordance with the legislation.

IV. ORGANIZATION OF THE CENTER'S ACTIVITIES

Agricultural Mechanization Engineers" conducts constant monitoring of the Center's activities for the effective fulfillment of its assigned tasks.

VII. PROCEDURE FOR FINANCING THE CENTER'S ACTIVITIES SOURCE AND PROPERTY

16. The following are defined as sources of financing for the Center's activities:

The Center's activities are financed from revenues from the provision of services on a contractual basis, budget funds allocated for the implementation of state research programs, extra-budgetary funds of the institute, as well as overhead costs of economic contracts concluded with various organizations, local and foreign grant funds allocated for research projects, as well as other activities within the framework of the powers granted to the Center, other sources not prohibited by law.

17. The Center can fully utilize the university's property in the prescribed manner.

18. The monthly salary of the Director of the Center is determined in accordance with the staffing table of the National Research University "Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers".

19. The Center exercises the right of ownership, use, and disposal of the property assigned to it by the Higher Educational Institution in the manner prescribed by law.

20. Profit from the Center's activities within its competence, after paying the relevant taxes and mandatory payments, is used for the development of the Center's material and technical base and material incentives for employees.

21. Property and funds acquired from income from economic and scientific-practical activities, as well as charitable, sponsorship funds and gratuitous receipts, are the property of the HEI.

VIII. FINAL RULES

22. Amendments and additions to this Regulation are made in the manner prescribed by law.

23. The Center may be liquidated or reorganized in accordance with the established procedure based on the recommendation of the University Council.
